6th June 2026

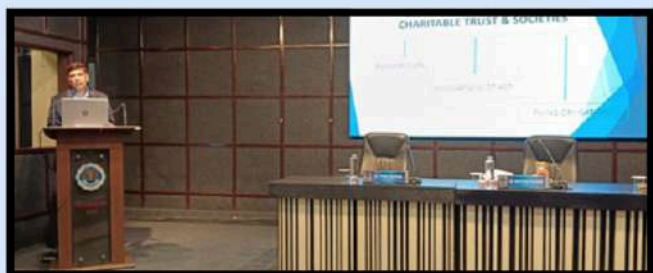

16th May, 2026

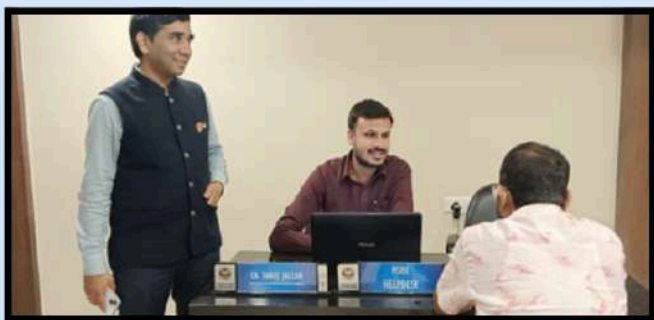

14th June 2026

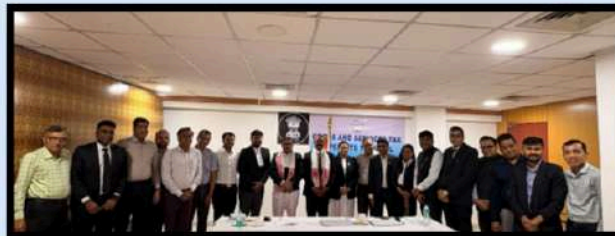

28th June 2026

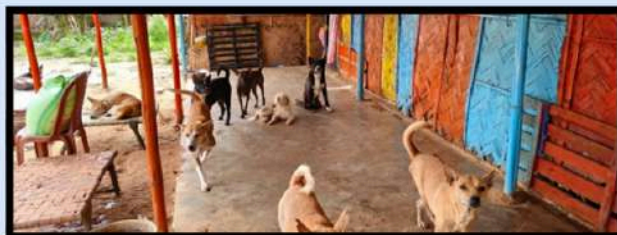

Seminar on GST rules

GUWAHATI, June 7: The Guwahati Branch of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) organised a seminar on 'GSTAT Appeal Filing' at the ICAI Bhawan here recently.

The programme was organised in view of the operationalisation of the Goods and Services Tax Appellate Tribunal (GSTAT) after a wait of more than eight years since the introduction of GST and the approaching deadline of June 30 for filing eligible pending appeals before the Tribunal.

The seminar commenced with the inaugural address by Somnath Ganguli, vice president and judicial member of GSTAT, Guwahati Bench, who shared insights on the GST law and functioning of the GSTAT.

He spoke on the role of the GSTAT in the GST dispute resolution mechanism and highlighted important aspects of appellate proceedings for professionals.

Speaking on the occasion, Anjan Kumar Mundhra, chairman of Guwahati Branch of ICAI, stated that the seminar has been organised at a crucial juncture as the due date for filing eligible pending GST appeals before the GSTAT is June 30.

Manoj Nahata deliberated on the legal framework governing GSTAT appeals and discussed key statutory provisions relevant to appellate proceedings.

Raginee Goyal demonstrated the online GSTAT appeal filing process.

ICAI Guwahati conducts seminar on GSTAT appeal filing

GUWAHATI, June 7: The Guwahati Branch of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) organized a seminar on "GSTAT Appeal Filing" on June 6, 2026, at ICAI Bhawan, Manik Nagar, Guwahati. The programme was organized in view of the operationalization of the Goods and Services Tax Appellate Tribunal (GSTAT) after a wait of more than eight years since the introduction of GST and the approaching deadline of June 30, 2026, for filing eligible pending appeals before the Tribunal.

The seminar commenced with the inaugural address by Shri Somnath Ganguli, Hon'ble Vice President and Judicial Member, GSTAT, Guwahati Bench, who shared valuable insights into GST law and the functioning of the GST Appellate Tribunal. Addressing the gathering, he elaborated on the role of GSTAT in the GST dispute resolution mechanism and highlighted important aspects of appellate proceedings for professionals. His address provided participants with a deeper understanding of the procedures and expectations of the appellate authorities, particularly in a e-filing environment.

Speaking on the occasion, CA Anjan Kumar Mundhra, Chairman of the Guwahati Branch, stated that the seminar had been organized at a crucial juncture, as the due date for filing eligible pending GST appeals before GSTAT is June 30, 2026. He emphasized that with GSTAT becoming functional after more than eight years of GST implementation, tax professionals must be adequately prepared to assist taxpayers in pursuing their appellate remedies within the prescribed timelines. He mentioned that the objective of the programme was to provide both legal and practical guidance on GSTAT appeals and to facilitate a smooth transition into the GST appellate regime, even if there were procedural issues or minor defects. CA Manoj Nahata deliberated on the legal framework governing GSTAT appeals and discussed key statutory provisions, procedural requirements and important considerations relevant to appellate proceedings. CA Raginee Goyal, Immediate Past Chairperson of the Guwahati Branch, demonstrated the online GSTAT appeal filing process and highlighted important procedural aspects, documentation requirements and
