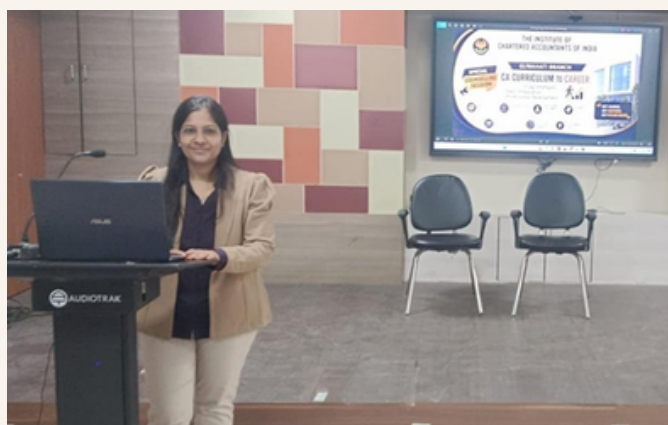
Counselling on "How to face CA Exam"
