Buzzing with energy as delegates arrive—ongoing kit distribution and spot registrations in full swing, marking the vibrant beginning of the experience.





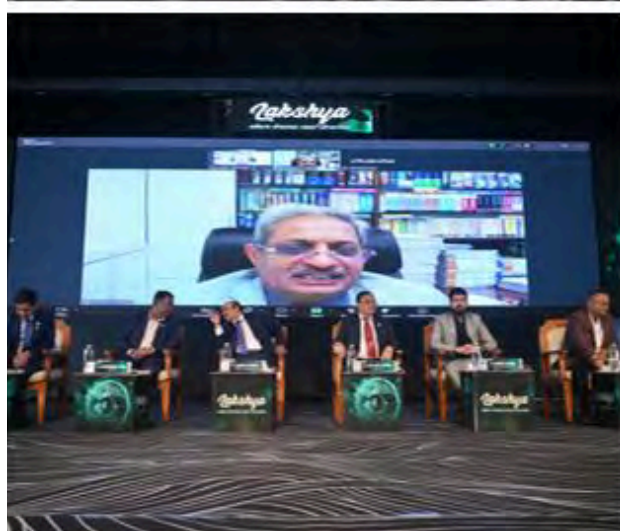
The conference was set into motion by a grand and power-packed Inaugural Session with an overwhelming and enthusiastic delegates.

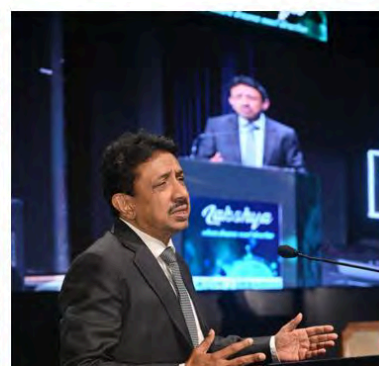

Delegates relished a sumptuous and refreshing lunch during the mid-day break



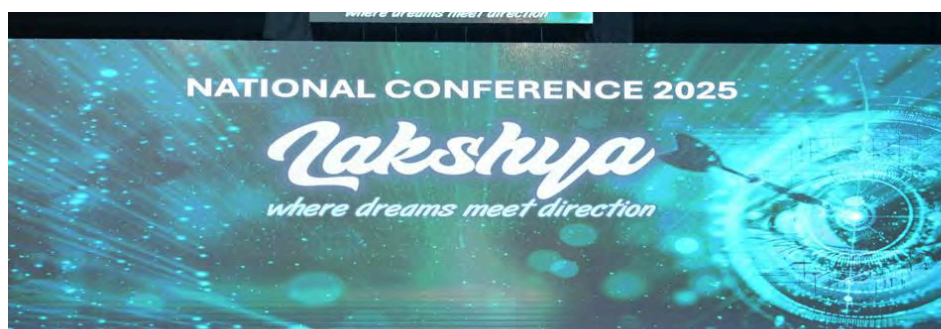

## National conference of CAs on December 19-20

GUWAHATI, Dec 17: The Guwahati branch (EIRC) of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) will host a two-day national conference of Chartered Accountants on December 19-20 at the Srimanta Sankaradeva International Auditorium here.

The event will bring together leading voices of the profession from across the country. Raginee Goyal, branch chairperson of ICAI and convener of the conference, said that the event will be inaugurated at 10 am on December 19 in the presence of past presidents of ICAI, council members, managing committee members of the Guwahati branch of ICAI, and senior professionals from across India.

Designed against the backdrop of rapid regulatory changes, increasing litigation, and technological disruption, the conference will feature six high-impact sessions addressing critical areas impacting the chartered accountancy profession.

"The technical deliberations will start with an in-depth study on 'Evidence and statements in GST proceedings', where JK Mittal will give practical in-

sights on investigations, appreciation of evidence, and legal standing and court room highlights on statements tendered in proceedings," Goyal said.

A discussion on the topic, 'Crystal gazing the profession - 2030 and beyond', featuring past presidents of ICAI, including Dr Debashis Mitra, will deliberate on leadership, relevance, and the evolving role of Chartered Accountants in the coming decade.

Anil Bhandari, an internationally acclaimed expert on Information Risk Management, Internal Audit, and Regulatory Compliance, and an honorary advisor to regulators like the RBI and TRAI, will speak on the topic 'Agentic AI vs Chartered Accountants - Will 2030 be a very different world for Chartered Accountants.'

Dr Girish Ahuja will talk on the recent new IT Act, which will become effective from April 1, 2026.

The programme will also include a special leadership session by the president of ICAI and other senior leaders of the body, highlighting the profession's role in governance, economic growth and nation building.

A talk show with Kunal

Saraogi, Sumeet Bagadia, and Nikunj Saraf on 'Capital markets, insights, and wealth creation' will be moderated by Ravi Kumar Patwa, central council member of ICAI.

The talk show is intended to offer insights and analysis on market trends and advisory opportunities for wealth creation in modern times.

Another attraction of the conference will be a motivational session to be delivered by Dr Deepak Vohra. He will speak on the topic 'The Jaamvant transformation - Unstoppable Bharat.'

A cultural evening is also scheduled on December 19, featuring a specially curated performance by Laksh Maheswari, a performance by the music band Voodoo Child, and a dance drama 'Gajanan Udbhav' to be performed by Chartered Accountants and CA students.

Branch secretary Jay Prakash Gupta said that the conference is expected to attract over 1,000 delegates, including members, students, and special invitees from across the country, and will serve as a platform for knowledge enrichment, professional networking, and meaningful engagement.

## Chartered Accountants Conference concludes at Guwahati

GUWAHATI, Dec 21: The two-day National Conference of Chartered Accountants concluded successfully on December 20 at the Srimanta Sankaradeva International Auditorium with a valedictory session led by CA Raginee Goyal, Chairperson of the Guwahati Branch of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

CA Ravi Kumar Patwa, Central Council Member and Programme Director, remained present throughout the conference, guiding and mentoring the Guwahati Branch. Held under the theme 'Lakshya - Where Dreams Meet Direction', the conference highlighted that Chartered Accountants remain irreplaceable in the evolving professional landscape.

Speakers emphasised that while artificial intelligence cannot replace CAs, the profession must increasingly adopt AI to enhance efficiency and capacity.

The importance of unlearning, learning and relearning, coupled with strong analytical skills and the ability to effectively use modern tools, was repeatedly underscored as a defining strength of the profession. The second day featured a session by CA (Dr) Girish Ahuja on 'Income Tax Act, 2025: Way Forward', offering insights into the new Income Tax Act scheduled to come into effect from April 1, 2026.

This was followed by a special leadership session addressed by CA Charanjot Singh Nanda, President of ICAI, along with other senior leaders of the Institute, focusing on the role of Chartered Accountants in governance, economic growth and nation-building.

The ICAI President highlighted that the Institute was established by an Act of Parliament even before the adoption of the Constitution, reflecting the profession's foundational role in building the nation.

Stressing continuous upskilling, lifelong learning and gratitude towards parents and spouses as guiding pillars, he urged members to participate in the World Forum of Accountants to be held on January 31, 2026, at Noida.

A session on capital markets and wealth creation, moderated by CA Ravi Kumar Patwa, featured expert deliberations by market professionals Sumeet Bagadia and Nikunj Saraf, who shared insights on market trends and advisory opportunities in contemporary times.

A patriotic motivational session titled "The Jaamvant Transformation - Unstoppable Bharat" was delivered by Dr Deepak Vohra, who aligned professional excellence with India's growth narrative and engaged the audience through an inspiring and interactive presentation.

Informing about the cultural segment, CA (Dr) Swati Tejawat, Chairperson of the Media and Publicity Committee, said that a colourful cultural evening themed "Samah - The Magical Night 5.0" was held on Friday, featuring a specially curated audio-visual performance by storyteller Laksh Maheswari on Assam's music icon Zubeen Garg, along with performances by the western music band Voodoo Child and a dance drama titled "Gajanan Udbhav" depicting the origin of Lord Ganesha, performed by CAs and CA students.
