- **Invitation for Stakeholder Feedback on the Review of the CA Scheme of Education & Training (31-07-2026):** ICAI invited students, members, academicians and other stakeholders to share suggestions for reviewing the CA Scheme of Education & Training. The initiative aims to align the curriculum with evolving professional and industry requirements.
- **Online Facility for Surrender of Exemption (30-07-2026):** ICAI introduced an online facility enabling eligible students to surrender exemptions for the CA Intermediate September 2026 and CA Final November 2026 examinations through the e-services portal.
- **Re-opening of Online Examination Application Forms (30-07-2026):** ICAI reopened the application window for the CA Final November 2026 examination, providing another opportunity for eligible candidates to submit their examination forms.
- **Inviting Public Comments on Proposed Stipend Rates (06-07-2026):** ICAI invited public comments on the proposed stipend rates for articled assistants undergoing two years of practical training under the New Scheme of Education & Training.
- **CA Foundation May 2026 Results Declared (03-07-2026):** ICAI declared the results of the CA Foundation Examination held in May 2026, enabling students to access their scorecards through the official examination portal.

Half-Day Seminar on the topic “ Income Tax Return Filing”

The Guwahati Branch of EICASA organized a Seminar on Income Tax Return (ITR) Filing on 5th July 2026 at ICAI Bhawan, Guwahati. The session was delivered by CA Deepesh Bharech, who shared valuable insights on the process of filing Income Tax Returns, selection of the appropriate ITR forms, applicable tax regimes, deductions, common filing errors, and important compliance requirements. He also addressed participants' queries through an interactive discussion, providing practical guidance on various aspects of income tax filing. The seminar witnessed the enthusiastic participation of 109 students and proved to be highly informative and beneficial, enabling participants to strengthen their practical knowledge of Income Tax Return filing and tax compliance.





Half-Day Seminar on the topic "How to ace 2 years of Articleship"

Full day Seminar on the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC)

The Guwahati Branch of EICASA organized a One-Day Seminar on the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) on 8th July 2026 at ICAI Bhawan, Guwahati. The session was delivered by CA Anshika Khatan, with the objective of providing CA students with a comprehensive understanding of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code and its significance in the Indian legal and financial framework. She explained the fundamental concepts of insolvency resolution, liquidation, the roles and responsibilities of Insolvency Professionals, the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process (CIRP), and the role of the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT). The speaker also discussed key provisions of the Code, recent developments, practical challenges, and important case-based insights, enabling students to understand the practical application of IBC in the corporate sector.





The seminar concluded with an interactive question-and-answer session, where participants actively engaged with the speaker and clarified their queries. The programme proved to be highly informative and beneficial, enhancing the participants' knowledge of insolvency laws and their practical relevance in the profession of Chartered Accountancy.

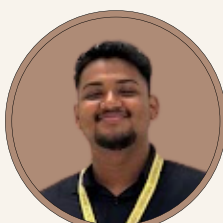
