ICAI seminar highlights global opportunities for chartered accountants

GUWAHATI, July 5: The Global Trade & Services Committee of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), in association with the Guwahati Branch of the Eastern India Regional Council (EIRC), organised a seminar on "Global Opportunities - India to the World" at Hotel Ornate, Guwahati, to equip chartered accountants with insights into emerging international opportunities.

The inaugural session began with a welcome address by CA Anjani Kumar Mundhra, Chairman of the Guwahati Branch (EIRC), who highlighted the significance of the seminar and the expanding global opportunities available to chartered accountants. The programme concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by CA Piyush Bimriwal, Secretary of the Guwahati Branch.

The seminar featured four technical presentations spread across three sessions, focusing on international accounting, global business services, taxation and digital transformation.

In the first session, CA Hitesh

"Global Capability Centers (GCCs) and Building a Global CA Practice - Strategy and Roadmap."

He outlined opportunities emerging from Global Capability Centres and shared strategies for developing an international professional practice.

This was followed by a session by CA Ravi Kumar Patwa, Programme Director, on "Changing Mindset to Attract International Clients," where he emphasised the need for Indian professionals to adopt a global outlook, strengthen client relationships and position themselves competitively in international markets.

The third session featured CA Mithilesh Reddy, who discussed opportunities in "Transfer Pricing and Cross-Border Tax Advisory," providing insights into international taxation and advisory services.
