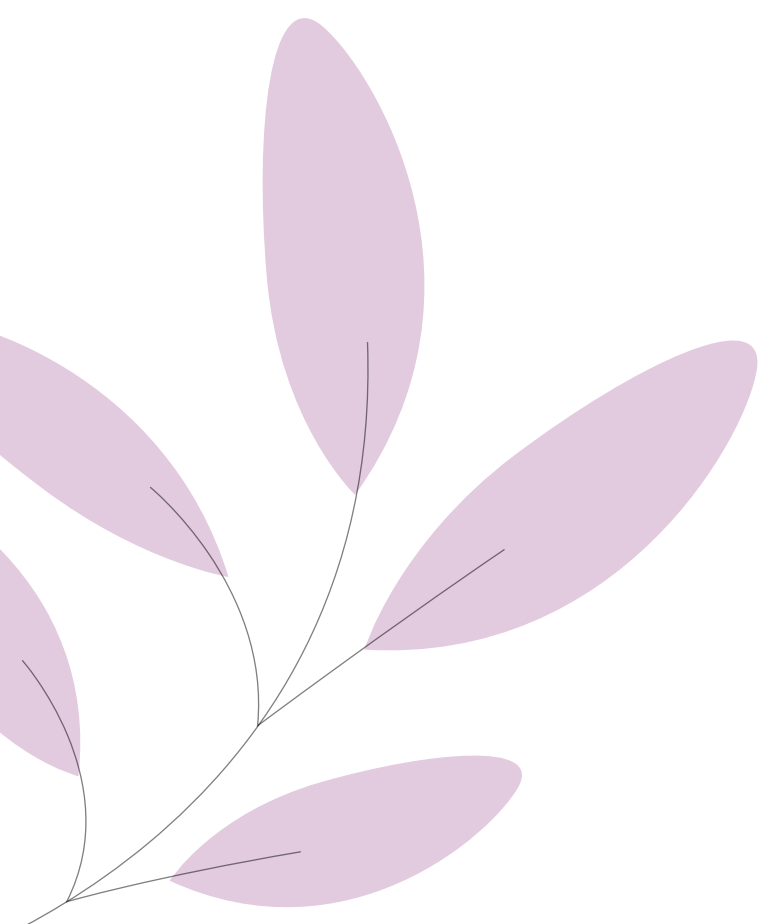

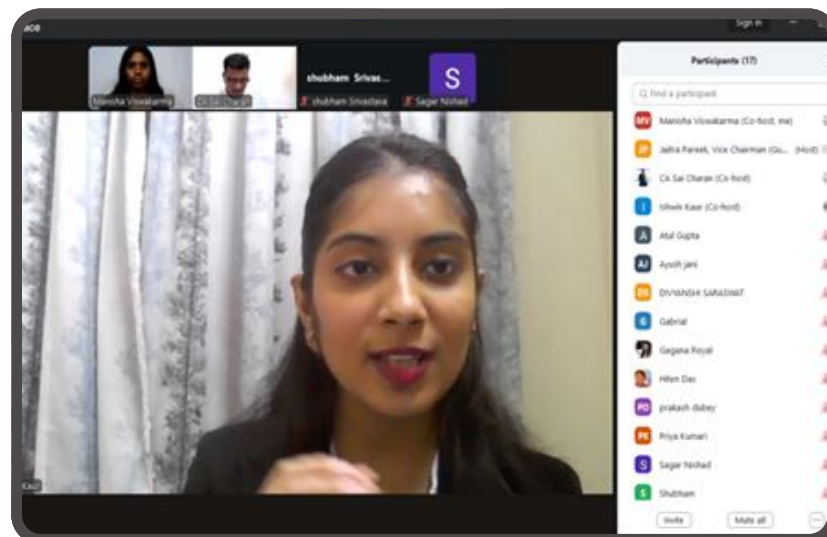
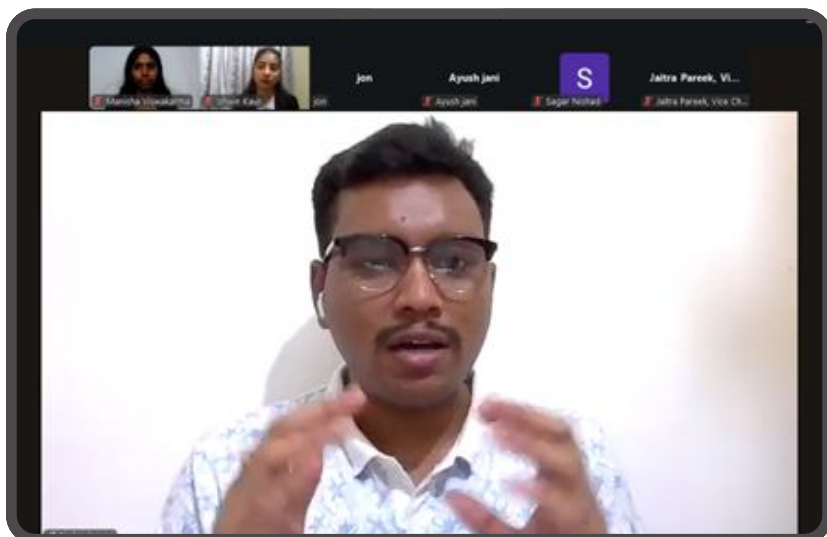
## Seminar on Accounts on ZOHO Books
